MidAtlantic Horse Rescue Receives Grants from Thoroughbred Charities of America and Blue Horse Charities

Chesapeake City, MD—MidAtlantic Horse Rescue, Inc. is proud to be the recipient of recent grants from Thoroughbred Charities of America and Blue Horse Charities.

Thoroughbred Charities of America, Inc. (TCA), based in Lexington, KY, is a charitable organization that provides grants to non-profit organizations that work toward improving the lives of Thoroughbred racehorses and the people who work with them. TCA offers the Thoroughbred industry and its supporters a way to give to one organization while helping many, and distributes grants to numerous organizations including rescue and adoption organizations. TCA has supported MidAtlantic Horse Rescue since their inception in 2002. The grant will be used to upgrade and maintain their facility at Woodstock Farm, to include installation of a wash stall and fertilizing pastures.

Blue Horse Charities, Inc. has also awarded funds to MidAtlantic Horse Rescue this month. Blue Horse Charities, Inc. was formed in 2001 to assist those providing homes for Thoroughbreds no longer suitable for breeding or racing. Funds are granted based on the number of successful adoptions into permanent homes. MidAtlantic Horse Rescue has received much needed support from Blue Horse Charities for 8 years, and all funds go towards the care and placement of their rescued thoroughbreds.
